Re: Update of the Certification of Subcontractor's Unemployment Insurance Payments Process

Please carefully review the information provided below and do not hesitate to contact DETR with any questions or concerns you may have. Thank you for working with us each year and we appreciate your cooperation.

1. Read and adhere to NRS 612.687. Failure to do so may result in the Prime Contractor being held liable for Subcontractor's delinquent taxes.

NRS 612.687 Liability of contractor to assure payment of amounts due from subcontractors.

- 1. Every contractor, as defined in NRS 624.020, who contracts with a subcontractor who is an employer under the provisions of this chapter or becomes such an employer before the completion of the contract shall, in connection with each such contract:
 - (a) Withhold sufficient money on the contract; or
 - (b) Require of such subcontractor a good and sufficient surety bond,
- to guarantee the payment of all contributions, penalties and interest which are due or become due pursuant to the provisions of this chapter with respect to wages paid for employment on the contract.
- 2. Any contractor who fails to comply with the provisions of subsection 1 is directly liable for all contributions, penalties and interest due from the subcontractor pursuant to the provisions of this chapter with respect to wages paid for employment on the contract, as if the services in question had been performed directly for the contractor, and the remedies of collection which are available to the Administrator under the provisions of this chapter against the subcontractor as employer are equally available against the contractor.
- 2. Effective immediately, your contact for new certification is Jo Anne Wiley. Please scan and email Jo Anne Wiley at JGWILEY@detr.nv.gov all new certification. They will be worked according to the order in which they are received. You must provide a list of the certifications included with each group submitted. We will return the completed list to you noting what has been completed or remains in pending status. NOTE: Please submit your certification requests in groups of up to 25 subcontractors per email due to file size limitations. You will receive a confirmation email as receipt of your file.
- 3. If you, or a subcontractor, have questions about Pending Certifications, please call 775-684-7311. The collections unit will be able to speak to you about any issues holding up the certification.
- 4. You will need to obtain signed forms for each job from subcontractors at the start of a job. Forms are required to be submitted prior to the final payout on the job; however, it is prudent to submit the form every quarter to ensure compliance with taxes as the job is in progress. The reporting form (RPT5098) can be obtained from our website at http://ui.nv.gov/ESSHTML/ui forms.htm.
- 5. Sections I and II must be completed in its entirety with correct information or the form will be returned to you unprocessed. NOTE: This requirement includes the clause in Section II which states the Prime certifies the contract has or has not been completed.
- 6. Requests will be reviewed, completed and returned to you as early as possible, but can take up to six (6) to eight (8) weeks following the end of the <u>current</u> quarter. Be sure to inform your subcontractors of this quarterly timeline. <u>DO NOT</u> refer your subcontractors to our office unless you have received notifications of "Pending" status from the agency.
- 7. Any <u>prior</u> quarter certification requests received at or near the quarterly delinquent date will not be processed until after our office has completed quarter end processing for the current quarter. During the time of the quarterly delinquent date, all staff are occupied with processing the incoming reports and payments and no staff will not be available to assist you until the quarterly mail process is completed (about one to two weeks around delinquent date of quarter).
- 8. In addition to the Subcontractor being in compliance with all Unemployment Insurance reports and payments, the Subcontractor will also be required to be in compliance with Bond reporting and payments.
