








## Saw personal income (nominal) grow by almost 6%







#### Unemployment rate increased everywhere




#### Despite the Federal support for income, jobs recovery stalls

#### % decline in 2020 payroll jobs




#### Maui and Kauai saw largest % decline in payroll jobs last year

#### US real GDP growth nears 6%, surpasses previous peak mid year




#### steady gains for HI sentiment, US weighed down by winter surge

#### March visitors close to 45% of 2019 arrivals


#### recovery stronger than 21Q1 optimistic scenario

#### Scenario with US arrivals recovering to 2017-18 levels






#### American Rescue Plan provides critical support during recovery

- Direct Payments to individuals, child and earned income tax credits
  - \$2.2 billion in benefits to Hawaii families
- ▶ \$2.2 billion to support State & County government.
- Close to \$1 billion in Enhanced Unemployment Benefits
  - extended to September 6 with \$300 plus up
  - \$10,200 of benefits not taxed at federal level
- Renter & Homeowner assistance, an additional \$152 million for Hawaii renters and \$50 million of mortgage assistance for homeowners
- Small Businesses
  - additional \$7.25 b nationally for additional PPP loans through March 31,2021.
  - additional funding for EIDL and EA grants, Shuttered Venue Operators grants.
  - New Restaurant Grant Program, \$28.6b nationally, up to \$10m per business
- ▶ Direct aide to K-12 and Universities, plus childcare block grants








#### TVRs are not showing up in single family for sale inventory



### But likely impacting lower end of condo market




## Despite limited home building, federal spending booms

#### Hawaii economy bounces back




#### **Analytics**


